MEKUNO – 2017 Information for Parents and Campers

This summer's program is being planned through a combined effort of the Church of God of the Abrahamic Faith memberships. **MEKUNO** is intended to be a two-week experience emphasizing service to GOD through service to others. The first week is a training period, while the second week stresses actual ministering to the needs of others.

Week one: TRAINING

<u>Sunday, July 9, through Saturday, July 15, 2017</u> at Camp Stigwandish, a Greater Western Reserve Council Boy Scout camp in Madison, Ohio, which has sleeping, dining, and recreational facilities appropriate to our needs, allowing us to <u>"Come out of their midst and be separate" (2Cor 6:17)</u>. The campground, located at 7506 Ross Rd, Madison, OH 44057, is tobacco, alcohol, and drug free.

Sunday, July 9

Arrive no later than 9:30 am at The Church of The Blessed Hope, 7450 Wilson Mills Road, Chesterland, OH 44026

- Campers should be dressed ready for camp
- At camp, we will conduct a worship service and breaking of bread
- Campers will participate in team-building activities
- Swimming in the camp's lake, weather permitting
- Review schedules for the week
- Finish the day with Bible reading

- devotions
- recreation
- social and snack time
- · discussion and group activities
- Bible reading

- A MEKUNO staff member will confirm all transportation prior to Saturday

Week two: SERVICE

- Service Placements are determined during Week One, when MEKUNO staff will match teenagers with needed service
- Please do not arrange your own Housing for Week Two. Arrangements will be made for each camper.
- Parents can be assured that they will be consulted in advance of Service and Housing placements. Before Week One concludes, Parents will be contacted with specific details regarding service, transportation, and lodging. At that time, parents will be given an opportunity to discuss any questions or concerns.

WHAT TO BRING:

Items recommended for the team building activities on Sunday July 9th, some items depend on weather:

- Wide margin Bible (See Registration Form page 1 if questions.) Please note, this must be a hard copy, not an
 electronic Bible.
- Modest and discrete clothing and swimwear (if you are unsure please call with questions)
- Discrete jeans, sweat pants, shorts, and shirts
- Comfortable, durable shoes or hiking boots to walk around camp, at times in the mud
- Sweatshirt and/or jacket
- Rainwear
- Insect repellent
- Sunscreen

Bedding and Linens:

- Sleeping bag or sheets & blankets to fit a twin-size bunk bed
- Pillow
- Towels
- Bag for dirty/wet laundry

Misc.:

- Toiletries (Deodorant, Shampoo, Toothpaste, Soap, etc.)
- Flashlight
- Creek walking shoes, if desired
- Favorite Bible reference books
- 1-2 dressier outfits for Sundays before and after Service Week

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

- Electronic Bibles
- Food to eat in your cabins (There is plenty to eat in the dining hall. Food kept in cabins will attract creatures with 4, 6 or more legs!)
